A *sabani* is a traditional wooden Okinawan sailboat. A fantastic marine culture was developed due to the oceans surrounding environment, and it is known that Okinawans used to travel across the ocean to other countries. *Sabani* boats used to be the most widespread ocean travel tool among the locals. In this program, participants will first

listen to information about *sabani*, then learn how to paddle and practice with a team in the morning. After lunch, they can take part in a *sabani* race.

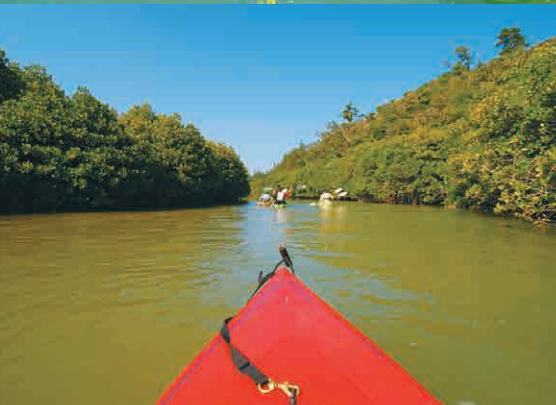

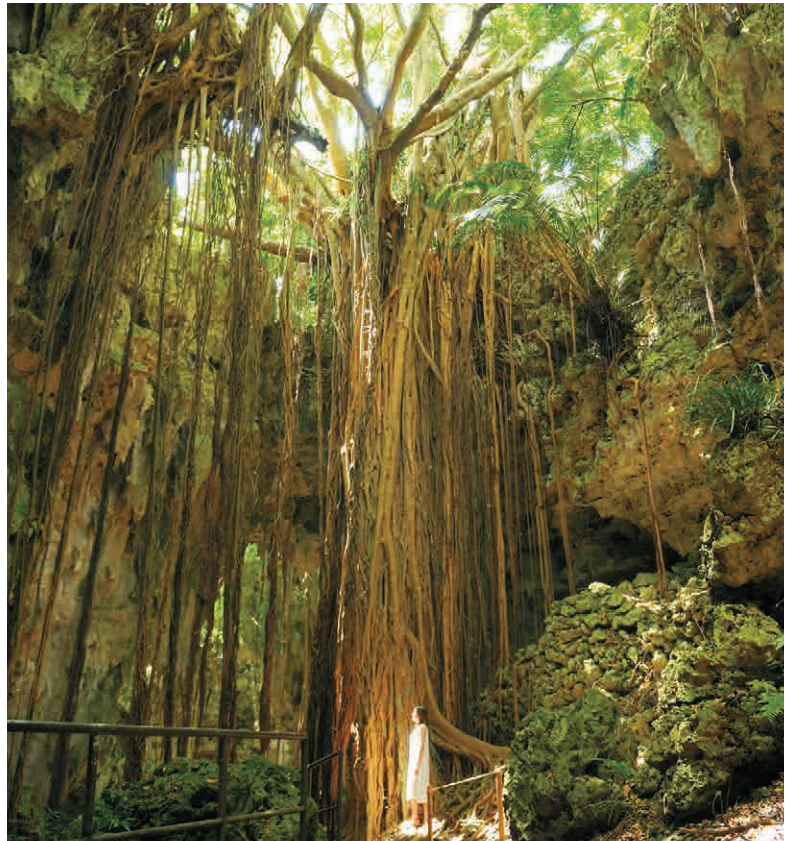
Valley of Gangala Guided Tour

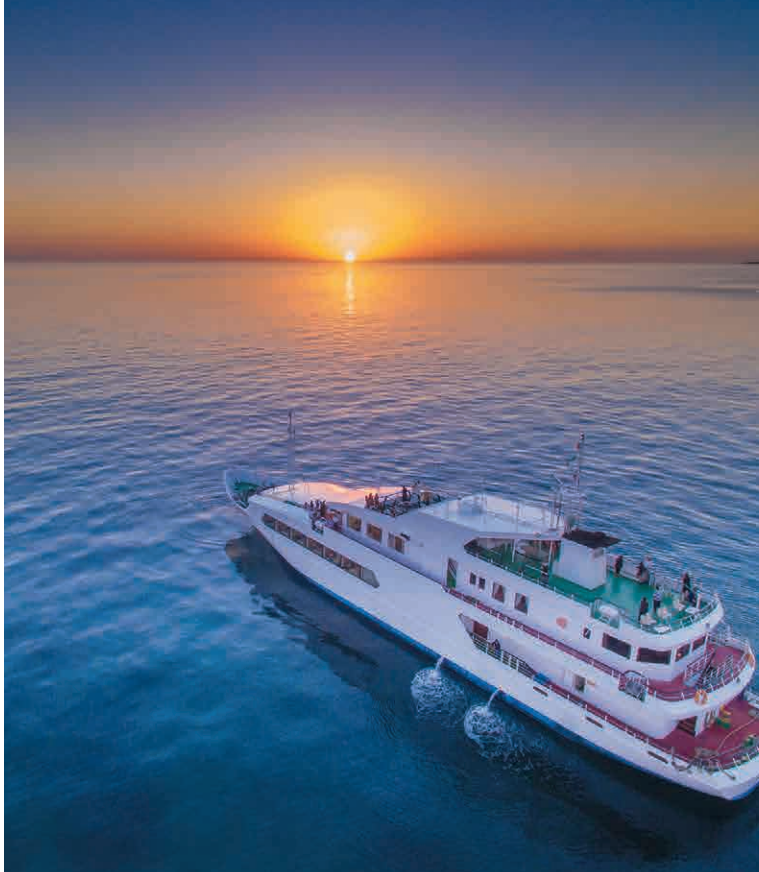
